CHANGE-MAKER, KASHIKA DPS SHARJAH

Kashika's environmental journey took a pivotal turn when she had the incredible opportunity to **meet Dr.** Jane Goodall at the Roots & Shoots Awards Ceremony in 2020 with her school team DPS Sharjah. This experience of meeting the legendary conservationist deeply moved and inspired Kashika, as she saw firsthand how one person's dedication could spark global change. Dr. Goodall's passion and lifelong commitment to environmental preservation solidified Kashika's belief that even small actions can make a meaningful difference. At just 11 years old, Kashika is already making waves in the world of climate action. Her passion led her to create Carbon Countdown (@carboncountdown.life), an Instagram platform where she shares practical tips to inspire others to adopt eco-friendly habits and combat climate change.





In addition to her digital advocacy, Kashika exhibited exceptional leadership during her time as the Environment President at her school. Last year, she spearheaded a variety of impactful initiatives, such as organizing recycling drives, launching energy-saving campaigns, and working closely with the school to instill a culture of sustainability among students. Kashika has also initiated a neighborhood recycling project with the Emirates Environmental Group (EEG). On a national level, she has won the ALEF ECO CHAMP award and recognition in the NET ZERO Competition.


